Lectures

Our very own Vickie Coleman is providing two lectures this year along with a bed turning from her private collection.

Be sure to join us as Vickie walks through quilt history and discusses dating your quilts.

American Quilt History, an Overview

A trip through quilt history and its relationship to events in American history and women's lives. The PowerPoint presentation covers highlights from Colonial America to the Centennial, The Second Quilt Revival (1880s to 1950s) and The Great Quilt Revival (1960s to 2010). A bed turning will feature quilts from the 1870s through 1970s.

How Old is My Quilt?: Clues to Date Your Quilt

Curious about how to determine the age of your quilt? Quilt style, patterns, colors, fabrics, and bindings/edge treatments all are clues to unraveling the mystery of a quilt's age. A bed turning will feature quilt examples demonstrating the five clues used in determining age. Resources on how to determine age of a quilt and information on how to care for your antique and vintage quilts will be provided.

Biography

Vickie Coleman opened *Bluegrass Quilt Appraisal, LLC* in 2018 following enrollment in the American Quilter's Society Appraisal Skills Course. Vickie has been appraising quilts since that time, apprenticing with AQS Certified Appraisers in Tennessee and Delaware. She is scheduled to test for national certification when AQS once again sponsors in-person events. Vickie has been involved in fabric dating classes and AQS Appraisal Classes, and has also studied at workshops and seminars offered by the American Quilt Study Group, Midwest Fabric Study Group, Tennessee Quilt Study Group, and the Daughters of the American Revolution in Washington, DC.

She has been involved with the study of textiles since 1972 through her undergraduate degree in textiles and clothing. Graduate work included a Master's of Science degree in Career and Technical Education and certification in Educational Leadership. Her involvement continued through her career in education as a Family and Consumer Sciences teacher of textiles and clothing; and at the University of Kentucky where she was a graduate assistant in the textile testing laboratory and an adjunct instructor of History of Costume and Textile Chemistry. As a professor and chair in the Textiles, Clothing and Merchandising program at Midway College, Vickie was also the Director of the Historic Costume Collection. Currently, she is an adjunct instructor at Eastern Kentucky University, teaching Introduction to Textiles and Advanced Apparel Design.

Most recently, Vickie has been working with the Kentucky Heritage Quilt Society as the Museum and Archives Chair and the Quilt Registrar of the Kentucky Quilt Documentation Project. She is a member of the Quilters' Guild of the Bluegrass, Kentucky Heritage Quilt Society, Quilters Hall of Fame, American Quilt Study Group, American Quilters' Society, Tennessee Quilt Study Group, Smoky Mountain Quilters Guild, and the Midwest Fabric Study Group. Vickie also lectures on *American Quilt History, an Overview; The Second Quilt Revival, 1880s to 1950s; The Great Quilt Revival, 1960s to 2010; How Old is My Quilt?: Clues to Date Your Quilt; Appraisal, Documentation, Judging: What is the Difference?; Quilt Appraising: Why You Should Have Your Quilt Appraised; and The Kentucky Quilt Registry: What is it and Why Should Quilts be Documented.*

Sleep Inn and Comfort Inn in Cave City are both part of the Choice Motel group, so are very similar. They are close to the convention center and have many amenities including free Wi-Fi, microwave, refrigerator, interior corridor, coffee maker, free hot breakfast buffet, indoor pool and guest laundry—in case you just HAVE to buy that piece of fabric from our vendor and prewash it before using it!

Both are three-story motels. If you prefer a ground floor room, be sure to specify that when you make your reservation. Rooms come in two varieties: 1 king bed or 2 queen beds.

Also, June is tourist season, so make your reservations early!

All rooms are \$92 plus taxes per night. 20 rooms between the Sleep Inn and Comfort Inn are being made available for reservation **until May 31**.

When making reservations at Sleep or Comfort, press 2 to speak to the front desk. (not reservations) and specify Kentucky Heritage Quilt Society (not KHQS).

Reservations must be made by calling the number above.


June is tourist season! So make your reservation EARLY!


